Sinoatrial (SA) node. The SA node has the highest rate of depolarization in the whole system, so it can start the beat and set the pace for the whole heart; thus the term “pacemaker “. Atrial contraction. From the SA node, the impulse spread through the atria to the AV node, and then the atria contract.
