Rice is the staple diet of more than half of the world's population. It is grown in flooded fields called paddies, because its roots need to be submerged in shallow water. Farmers have even found a way to grow rice on steep mountains, using terraces. Like wheat, maize, and barley, rice is a cereal (edible grass).
