Step 3: Preparation of Fund Flow Statement: After recognizing the funds/loss from operations, fund flow statement is prepared, which will show the net increase or decrease in the working capital. Basically, any change in the assets and liabilities may result in the inflows and outflows of funds, but not always, as in case of depreciation or revaluation of assets, there is no inflow or outflow of funds.
