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National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy ...

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a series of tests focused on basic skills that are administered annually to Australian students. These standardised tests assess students' reading, writing, language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy and are administered by the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA).

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is an annual assessment for students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. NAPLAN is a nationwide measure through which parents, teachers, schools, education authorities, governments and the broader community can determine whether or not young Australians are developing the literacy and numeracy skills that provide the critical foundation for other learning and for their productive and rewarding participation in the community.

Three sample assessments are administered nationally in Australia: NAP- Civics and Citizenship (NAP-CC), NAP-science literacy (NAP-SL), and NAP-Information and Communication Technology Literacy (NAP-ICTL). Each assessment is administered once every three years on a rolling basis.

2.1 NAPLAN is an annual assessment of Australian students in years 3, 5, 7 and 9 that tests students in reading, writing, language and literacy. The test has been conducted in May each year since 2008, and results are available four months later in September. Since 2010 results have been available publically on the

National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy Professional development uses National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) data for teachers to get to understand the strengths and weakness within their classes and to program accordingly. Students are identified for extra assistance or withdrawal tutoring using the NAPLAN results.

National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy ...

The National Assessment Program (NAP) tested 10,500 Year 6 and Year 10 students from 650 government, Catholic and independent schools in cities and rural areas at the end of 2014. It compared their results with its previous assessment in 2011, and discovered the average computer technology literacy of students in both year levels had dropped.
