Most of the work was done by human or animal labor as the country lacked the machine-driven production methods that were emerging in Europe at the time.

Alongside the production of cotton and woolen cloth, which formed the backbone of the Industrial Revolution in the United States as in Britain, other crafts increasingly became mechanized and centralized in factories in the first half of the nineteenth century.
